



## **Construction Advisory for Veterinary Teaching Hospital Clients and Purdue University School of Veterinary Medicine Visitors**

Harrison Street in front of the Purdue University School of Veterinary Medicine has re-opened; however, it remains closed west of Lynn Hall. Additionally, more construction work is pending elsewhere on campus. Therefore, *clients of the Veterinary Teaching Hospital are still advised to utilize alternate routes, as described below*. ### **For Clients of the Veterinary Teaching Hospital**

#### **To Access the Small Animal Hospital/Animal Emergency Service:**

Take Grant Street (on the east side of the Purdue University campus) to Harrison St. Drive West on Harrison to the stop sign at the intersection of Masteller. Turn South into the drive between the parking lot and the Small Animal Hospital. Continue around the curve to the parking lot entrance. Hospital clients should park in the designated VTH parking spaces and register at the front desk with your vehicle license plate number.

#### **To Access the Large Animal Hospital**

When arriving from the east, north or south (via SR 43/US 231): Take SR 43/US 231 to Ahlers Road, which is the first drive south of Williams Street (if coming from the north or east it is just after the railroad overpass or, if coming from the southeast, the last drive to the left before the RR overpass). Follow Ahlers Road to the stop sign at the intersection with S. Russell Drive. Turn right onto S. Russell Drive. Follow the signage, which will direct you to a temporary drive just past a railroad crossing. Turn right onto the temporary drive, and follow the signs that will then direct you left to an entrance into the veterinary complex. Additional signs will direct you through parking areas to the Large Animal Hospital.

When arriving from the west (via State Road 26): Follow State Road 26 to University Drive. Turn right, and follow University to Harrison Street. Cross Harrison Street and continue through the Large Animal Parking lot to the Large Animal Hospital entrance.
