

JOB PLACEMENT FOR SENIOR VETERINARY STUDENTS AT PUSVM

Job Listing

Use the standard format required for posting employment opportunities through this service. Information can be submitted via the WEB or fax. Employment opportunities are entered into a database that is customized by geographic location and primary interest for each of our soon-to-be graduates. Information that needs to be included to catch the graduates attention include: type of practice, number of doctors and technicians employed, salary range, benefits, case load, emergency duty, etc. The more specific the information, the better. A listing of opportunities is placed in each future graduates' hands for their review. Paper copies of these opportunities are kept on file in the Student Services Office for students' perusal during regular working hours.
